Europe Trip 2006



People have been asking about the next European ski trip, and on the following page you'll see the sign-up form for next year's destination, **Selva Val Gardena** in Italy.

Selva is in the Dolomite region of northeastern Italy, and some old-timers might remember we were in the neighborhood in 1998. That year we were in Canazei, which is the next valley south (or counterclockwise on the Sella Ronda circuit) from Selva. **It is interconnected to about 200 ski lifts in the Dolomiti Super Ski area where your lift pass covers up to 450 lifts in the region.** Selva has a very Austrian character, as until 1919, it was part of the Tyrol region of Austria, and German is spoken by many of the locals. In fact, it's alternate name is Wolkenstein. The scenery is spectacular, high limestone cliffs tower above mostly gentle ski runs which fan out in all directions. It is the home of the Sella Ronda circuit, which takes you through all four valleys radiating out from the Sella Massif, bringing you back where you started 28 miles later.



We will be staying at the **4-star Hotel Oswald** in the center of town, walking distance to the lifts, or take the free ski shuttle if you don't feel like walking. As usual for a European trip, both breakfast and dinner are included. Breakfast is

buffet style with coffee, tea, juices, bread, cheese, cold cuts, cereal and yogurt. Dinners will be multi-course gourmet meals with a combination of Italian and Tyrolean specialties.

As in past years, we will bus from Appleton to Chicago O'Hare and fly nonstop to Milan, Italy. A charter bus will then take us to Selva, about 5 hours away.



Our side trip will be a 3-day stopover in **Rome** after leaving Selva. We have a 3-star hotel in the heart of Rome. We will fly there from Venice airport and then return back to Chicago via Milan. In Rome, only breakfast is included with the package.

You may have experienced a bit of "sticker shock" when you saw the price. Europe is quite a bit more expensive than in past years with the weakening of the US Dollar versus the Euro. Still, I think it is a good value considering the quality of the accommodations, extent of the skiing, and grandeur of the surrounding Dolomite Mountains. As we are running a 4-day Jackson Hole trip at the same time, you'll still have some opportunity to ski if this one doesn't fit your budget or time availability.

Space on the Europe Trip 2006 is limited. We only have 44 confirmed slots; so if you want to go, send your sign-up form and a check ASAP after the August 15 trip opening date.

All pricing is based on double occupancy. Single occupancy prices on request

1. Pricing is based on an exchange rate of 0.81 EU = \$1.00 for the hotel, ground and lift passes. Changes in the exchange rate may increase or decrease the trip price. In the event that the exchange rate falls below 0.81 EU/\$ at the time of the tour operators payments, you will be responsible for paying the difference. If, on the other hand, the exchange rate is above 0.81 EU/\$ at the time of payments, you will receive a rebate after the trip is complete. (PS. At the time of writing the exchange rate is 0.83 EU = \$1.00.)
2. The following cancellation fee schedule will apply for any reason including, but not limited to: financial hardship, loss or change of job, injury, illness, or death of you or a family member.

After Sept 15: \$200 After Oct 4: \$400 After Nov 1: \$900 After Dec 5: Full amount of the trip

Cancellation fees may be waived by the trip leader if a replacement for the spot can be found. After Dec 5, this will be difficult, so consider taking trip cancellation insurance if you have any doubts.

3. You must have a valid passport before departure. If you don't have one, now apply for one immediately after you sign up. Birth Date is required for airline ticketing.

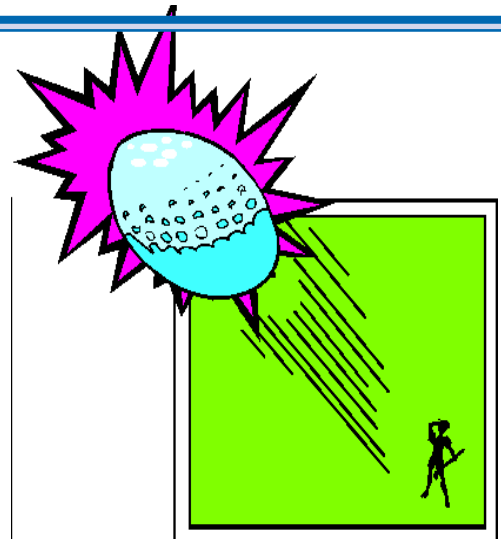
