and OLD sunglasses.



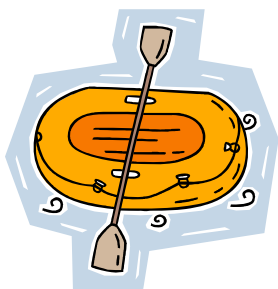
