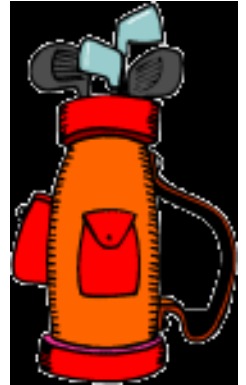


SPRING GOLF OUTING TIMBERSTONE GOLF COURSE
