## Taos Trip Re-Cap

On January 23<sup>rd</sup> our trip to Taos began. We had people leaving from Green Bay and Appleton by different flights and people arranging their own transportation. All the flights went smoothly and after our arrival into Albuquerque we loaded the bus for the ride to Taos Ski Valley. On the way we stopped in the town of Taos at an Albertson's to stock up on the necessary supplies that we would need for a week. We arrived at Taos Ski Valley in the early evening and got settled in.

Our base of operations for the week was the Inn at Snakedance, located at the base of the mountain, fifty feet from the number one chairlift, ideal ski in and ski out. Everyone on the trip received a fleece vest with the Inn at Snakedance logo and the Gelandesprung logo. These were waiting for us in our condos upon our arrival. The first night we were treated to a welcome wine and cheese party hosted by the Inn at Snakedance. Presentations were given by representatives from the Inn at Snakedance, the ski mountain and the ski school.

Sunday was our first opportunity to ski. During our week, the ski school was offering an instruction package they called Ski Week for \$99. What you got was a two hour lesson each day, everyday that you skied. We had 42 people sign up of the 52 people that were on the trip. The first thing we did was ski down a short run and get assigned to our lesson group. Then it was off to meet the mountain and learn how to ski the right way. Taos has one of the best ski schools in the nation and I would agree. The instructors worked everyone hard and had them skiing above the ability they had when we first arrived. It was a great opportunity.



Monday evening our group was given a special treat. We were all invited to the personal residence of Roger and Diane Marianni, the general manager of the Inn at Snakedance. On the way we stopped to see the Rio Grande Gorge. From the bridge we could look down to the river approximately 650 feet below, and the weather and timing were right for a beautiful sunset. Then we arrived at the Marianni residence and were warmly received. Their home is beautiful and the hospitality second to none. We were treated to towers of margaritas and Roger brought out many bottles of wine from the wine room. There was a huge table of hors d'oeuvres to choose from. After all of this, we still had to eat fajitas. It was wonderful, but it was time to return to our condos for the night, so we had to say good-bye and thank you. I do not think that our clubs experienced an event like this before. It was amazing how efficiently Roger and Diane handled a group our size.

The remainder of the week flew by with more skiing and fun things to do. The Inn at Snakedance offered a shuttle transport to the town of Taos each day and many people took advantage of this to see what was there and to do some shopping and dining out. It was an excellent choice for those people taking a day off to rest up from all of the skiing, or just to spend the evening after the day on the mountain.

Friday evening we had our farewell party. The Inn at Snakedance closed their dining room to the public so that it was all ours. We had an excellent meal, then the usual business items to attend to. The final details of our departure were given out. Pins from the mountain were given to Dennis Godar and Judy Van Caster to remember their first out west trip with the club. Penny Holman also received a pin to commemorate her first trip back with the club after her bicycling accident. The final item that needed to be taken care of was the Obtuse Award. It goes to the person doing the most unusual thing during the week. We had nominations for a person falling asleep during the orientation on Saturday evening, people consuming more beverages than they should have, leaving their jacket at the bar, and a few other things. The winner was Dwayne Whifield's nomination of Linda Sheard for getting ready to ski, and at the last minute realizing that she had not put on her ski pants.

Saturday morning was our departure from the Inn at Snakedance and the bus ride to the airport. The flights were on time and things went smoothly but we did have some long layovers so we arrived to our final destinations late in the evening. We said our last good-bys at the airport and so ended our one week adventure to Taos, New Mexico.

It was a great trip, things went well and there were no major injuries. I want to thank you all for signing up and I hope you do the same next year. Also, I want to thank Ron Quick for being the assistant trip leader and helping out wherever and whenever it was needed.

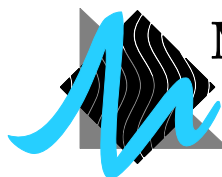

- ◆ Smoking is not allowed on the bus. Reasonable efforts will be made to accommodate smokers.
- ◆ Any additional trip surcharges incurred by the Club will be passed along to those participating on the trip. (Fuel surcharges, etc.)
- ◆ All payments & signed waivers should be mailed to the: **Gelandesprung Ski Club, PO Box 10422, Green Bay, WI 54307-0422**
- ◆ All patrons on Gelandesprung Sponsored trips must have a signed Gelandesprung Waiver.
- ◆ Non-members are able to sign-up on trips 30 days prior.
- ◆ Beer, Wine and Soda is provided on all bus trips; therefore a 21 year-old age restriction applies. YOU MUST BE AT LEAST 21.

#### REFUND & DISCOUNT POLICY

- ◆ Trips are priced at the club's cost per individual
- ◆ Any variations to trip descriptions must be requested 30 days prior and require board approval
- ◆ Midwest bus trips are based on a minimum number of riders (normally 5 people less than bus capacity). If someone desires to drive themselves, there will be no discount for the bus portion of the trip fee until the minimum number has signed up.
- ◆ If events on the hill are included in the lift ticket price, (lunch, Nastar race etc) the club will not give a discount for the lift tickets.
- ◆ If the club has made payments (partial or full to the vendor) and the amount isn't refundable, the individual requesting a refund will assume their share of this payment.
