I want to thank everyone who helped on this trip and all who went. Look for ward to next year as we learned Boyne Highlands is expanding with another lift and new territory to ski.

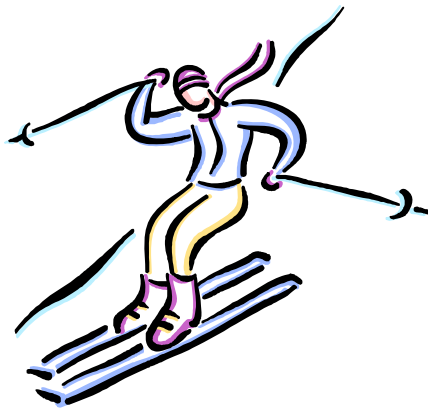
