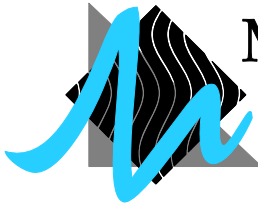

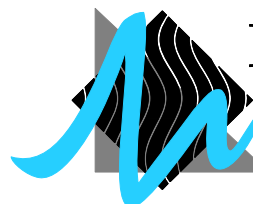

- Basic trip includes:** Bus transfer from Appleton/ Green Bay to Chicago O'Hare.  
Round trip air from Chicago to Munich on US Air.  
Round trip bus transfer between Munich and Sölden.  
7 Nights lodging at the 3 Star Hotel Tyrol, 7 Gourmet Dinners and 7 Breakfasts.
- Lift Pass includes:** 6 day lift pass covering Sölden with option of one day at Obergurgl.  
Sölden has 34 lifts, 6600 ft vertical, 90 miles for runs, 2 glaciers.  
Obergurgl has 24 lifts, 4100 ft vertical, 70 miles of runs.
- Munich ext.:** Bus transfers to Munich and return air to Chicago.  
3 nights lodging at the 4 Star Kings Hotel First Class in the Center of Munich with daily breakfast buffet, ½ day city tour with guide.  
Dinner at the Hofbrau Haus with one mass(liter) of beer.  
Bus transfer from Chicago O'Hare to Appleton

**Payment schedule:** \$500 deposit, due upon registration    \$500 2<sup>nd</sup> pmt. due on or before Aug 25  
\$500 due on or before Oct 6    Final balance due on or before Nov 17

The trip is open for deposits on July 15, 2010. Do not send money before this date! Payments post marked prior to July 15, 2010 will be registered after those post marked on July 15. There are a total of 66 spots available. Please read the accompanying terms and sign the application form and mail with your check payable to "Sly Fox Ski Club"

### Terms and Conditions

1. All pricing is based on double occupancy. Single occupancy prices on request
2. Pricing is based on an exchange rate of 1.00€=\$1.24 for the hotel, ground and lift passes. Changes in the exchange rate may increase or decrease the trip price. In the event that the exchange rate above \$1.24/€ at the time of the tour operators payments, you will be responsible for paying the difference. If, on the other hand, the exchange rate is below \$1.24/€ at the time of payments, you will receive a rebate after the trip is complete. (PS. At the time of writing the exchange rate is 1.24 SF = \$1.00.)
3. The following cancellation fee schedule will apply for any reason including, but not limited to: financial hardship, loss or change of job, injury, illness, or death of you or a family member.  
After Oct 6: \$200    After Nov 17: \$350    After Dec 15: \$500    After Jan 5: full amount of the trip  
Cancellation fees may be waived by the trip leader if a replacement for the spot can be found. After Dec 5, this will be difficult, so consider taking trip cancellation insurance if you have any doubts.
4. You must have a valid passport with an expiration no earlier than August 1, 2011 before departure. If you don't have one, now apply for one immediately after you sign up. Birth Date and Passport info are required for airline ticketing.
5. You must be a member of the Sly Fox Ski Club or the Gelandesprung Ski Club in order to participate. Dues must be paid by signup.
6. You must have a signed trip waiver on file with the Sly Fox Ski Club.
7. If you do not want to go on to Munich, you must provide your own transport from O'Hare airport home.

## Telluride Report

Thirty Four skiers started out on this trip beginning at 3 in the morning, Saturday, March 27. After a 3 hour bus ride to Chicago, they boarded their American Airlines nonstop to Montrose, Co. From there, it was another 2 hour bus ride to Telluride, where they were joined by others from Pittsburgh, Pagosa Springs, Phoenix, Chicago, and De Pere. Now 48 of us had just one more hour wait in the lobby while Bear Creek Lodge finished cleaning the rooms, and we were in. Jim and Sandy McMonagle, our trip leaders, along with their roomies, Bob and Judy Schmidt, Scott Nerenhausen and Tom Sitter, hosted our own Welcome Wine and Cheese party.

Bear Creek Lodge was quite luxurious, with their own private ski lift to the slopes. This curious contraption was a little bigger than a phone booth (remember those) on a railroad track that held a max of 6 people. It worked like an elevator, so you loaded up, pushed the button, and it rode you down 200 yards to the run. Coming home, you just stopped there on the side of the run, and pushed the button to call the lift if it wasn't already there, and up you went to the Lodge.

Sunday and Monday were warm, sunny days: typical Colorado March skiing. Everyone explored this huge area with lots of terrain for all skiing abilities. From the top of Gold Hill lift you could see all the way to Utah and the La Sal Mountains, or across the Bear Creek Canyon and watch the crazies powder skiing after a 4 hour hike. Take "The Plunge", a groomed black diamond run straight down into the town of Telluride, or stay on "See Forever", a blue cruiser all the way to the Mountain Village. Lots of green runs off of the 10 chair.

Tuesday was our fondue hillside picnic at the top of 10 chair. Deb Bramschreiber served up fresh cheese fondue and with sausage, bread, and wine. The sky was getting cloudy. Snow is coming.

Both the Mountain Village where we were staying, and the town of Telluride have lots of bars and restaurants. Many are on the pricey end, but there were still plenty of reasonable places to eat. The grocery store was next to the town gondola and the Lodge shuttle would take you there and bring you back. Speaking of gondolas, that is how you got between the town and the Mountain Village. The gondola ran until midnight and you could ride for free, saving a 5 mile journey by car.

Wednesday evening, the Lodge hosted a wine and cheese party for all the guests. With 2 ski clubs in the Lodge (us and Milwaukee Sitzmark) they had to break into their reserves. As we chatted in the lobby, we watched the snow dumping outside. Powder day tomorrow!

Thursday was indeed a powder day and it continued snowing lightly all day. Lots of hoopin' n' hollerin'. Friday was our last ski day. With the snow tapering off it looked like the end of a perfect week. Then we got the news that Julie Steltz, on her last run, got run over by a 12 year old snowboarder. Julie had to go to Grand Junction Hospital by ambulance. Her room mate, Kathy Heraly, accompanied her in the ambulance (earning Kathy the Angel Award).

That night, we had our trip ending banquet, somewhat subdued because of the news. The Capella Hotel in Mountain Village put on a wonderful dinner for us. Since it was the last week Telluride would be open, I think they gave us a special deal. After final departure details were covered, it was time for The Lunar Award. We must be getting good, because there were not too many nominations. We had to settle though, on Charlie Mineau. Charlie could not figure out why his clothes were not getting clean in the washer/dryer units in the condo. It turns out, because he kept turning on the dryer unit instead of the washer unit! Charlie got a pet snow snake with instructions on the care and feeding of the same.

Saturday morning we loaded up the bus and took off for Montrose. Julie and Kathy's other room mates (Tom & Karen Bohn, and Pete & Terry Stankevitz) packed up and loaded their stuff for them. They got the word that both Kathy and Julie would meet us at Montrose. We stopped along the way for a group photo outside of Ralph Lauren's 16,000 acre Double RL Ranch.
